ARMELLE GLOAGUEN FOUNDER

More than an experienced French teacher, Armelle is also an accomplished musician and world music instructor.

She is sought-after as a composer, musician, singer and language educator. She is certified as an early childhood artist teacher specializing in music and theater from the University of Reims, France.

She has built a solid reputation in Europe, the United States and South America over the past 20 years.



LEARN FRENCH AND SPANISH THROUGH MUSIC

At early childhood, pre-school and elementary levels, language teaching through music is a tried and true technique. In a 2007 report, "Singing in a Foreign Language," the French Ministry of Education stressed that music better teaches the rhythm of the target language and its structure. The repeated melody, often stubbornly stuck in one's head and coupled with a playful activity, solidifies memorization.

Armelle's multi-sensory technique is based on the use of songs, simple musical instruments and marionettes. Her teaching method is efficient, playful and dynamic. Children acquire vocabulary, sentence structures and idiomatic phrases in the joyous act of singing. This repetition of all elements achieved through music, in song, is an excellent way to improve comprehension and verbal practice. She developed it initially to teach French, Spanish and English to children between 6 months and eight years of age.

- Learn to concentrate and follow instructions,
- Learn balanced social and emotional behavior through teamwork and cooperation

Our humanitarian project uses music as a tool of adaptation and as an emotional outlet to help children find stability through new experiences. Our donors help in the organization of musical workshops for small groups by age and interest.

In August of 2016, Armelle For Kids travelled to Calais in northern France to support refugee children from Afghanistan, Iraq and Eritia. Many of them had lived through tragic experiences and were suffering on a daily basis.


